We are looking for 15 community members, sporting and physical activity clubs and/or community groups who have a disability or deliver disability sport programs and are willing to share their stories of how they contribute to their communities.

The initiative aims to ensure individuals, families and communities have the best opportunity to thrive and have the capacity to respond to emerging needs and challenges.

Phase one and two (already commenced):

 Professional Production Company will mentor four paid professional placement opportunities for Screen Practitioners who identify as disability diverse to develop their skills as a Writer, Director of Photography, Sound Recordist and Editor. This phase:

Carers WA will support the selection process to find 15 storytellers who have stories of

inclusion in sport and recreation. We are looking for stories about sport and physical activity

and how this has driven inclusion and accessibility within your community.

community club?

How has participating in your sporting activities helped you to feel included in your

community?

• Are you trying to join a sport club or participate in a new sport and facing obstacles

or barriers?

• How has your club contributed to a more inclusive and accessible community?

Do you see your club contributing to a more inclusive and accessible future? What

are your hopes and dreams for the future?

Assessment Criteria

Carers WA and Screenwest will assess all stories against the following assessment criteria:

Potential to contribute unique sporting inclusion perspectives in Western Australia.

• Storytelling mode e.g. verbal, augmented communication, text to speech, Auslan

• Willingness to tell your story on camera – with or without support.

If you have an inclusion story that promotes 'Filming our future' through sport and
