
About Carers WA

Carers WA is a non-profit, community-based organisation and registered charity dedicated to improving the lives of the estimated 230,000 family carers living in Western Australia. Part of the National Network of Carers Associations, we are the peak body recognised by both state and federal governments as the voice of family carers.

Carers WA aims to enhance and support the empowerment and wellbeing of carers through a range of innovative programs and services, providing practical and emotional support. Carers WA is also the lead provider of Carer Gateway services in WA.

Our role is to work in active partnership with carers, people with care and support needs, health professionals, service providers, government and the wider community. Carers WA also advocates for improved services and supports for carers by addressing carer issues at a state and federal level to influence government and other decision makers.





Who are carers?

A carer is someone who provides unpaid care and support to family members and friends who are living with a disability, mental health challenge, long term health condition (including a chronic condition or terminal illness), an alcohol or other drug dependency, or who is frail aged. Carers range in age from as young as eight to people well into their nineties. Most carers provide care for a parent, partner, child or friend. Carers WA helps carers in any caring situation.

The theme of the Carers WA Conference 2022 is 'Inclusion, Innovation, Inspiration: Caring in the Community'.


The Carers WA Conference 2022 will acknowledge and celebrate the work of Western Australia's carers and bring together a mixed audience of policy makers, service providers, support organisations, health professionals, and carers, to discuss current and emerging issues, share information and ideas, and enhance partnerships and networking.

Through a range of plenary sessions, panel discussions, fireside chats and breakout sessions, the Conference will explore common issues and trends relating to, and impacting on, carers and the changing landscape of caring, with participation and

presentations from a range of community sector leaders, health professionals and of course, carers themselves. The Conference will also highlight initiatives aimed at enhancing carer health, wellbeing and resilience, reinforced by the inclusion of a Wellness Room for delegates to take a break during the Conference.

The event will launch National Carers Week 2022 in Western Australia, an awareness week which aims to recognise, acknowledge and celebrate the role of carers through a variety of events and activities.

The full conference will be presented in-person at the Perth Convention and Exhibition Centre.

Cancellations received after 31 July 2022 will not be entitled to any refund and will be liable for payment of the full amount. All payments will be refunded should the conference be cancelled or rescheduled.
