Carer Gateway is an Australian Government initiative providing a mix of free digital and in-person supports, services and advice, for family carers in Australia. These services have been specifically designed and tested by carers to help reduce stress and build resilience in the caring role.

In Western Australia, Carers WA leads the delivery of Carer Gateway services. To access relevant supports, carers must complete a planning session to develop a personalised and tailored action plan to determine which supports are best matched to the carer's individual circumstances.
