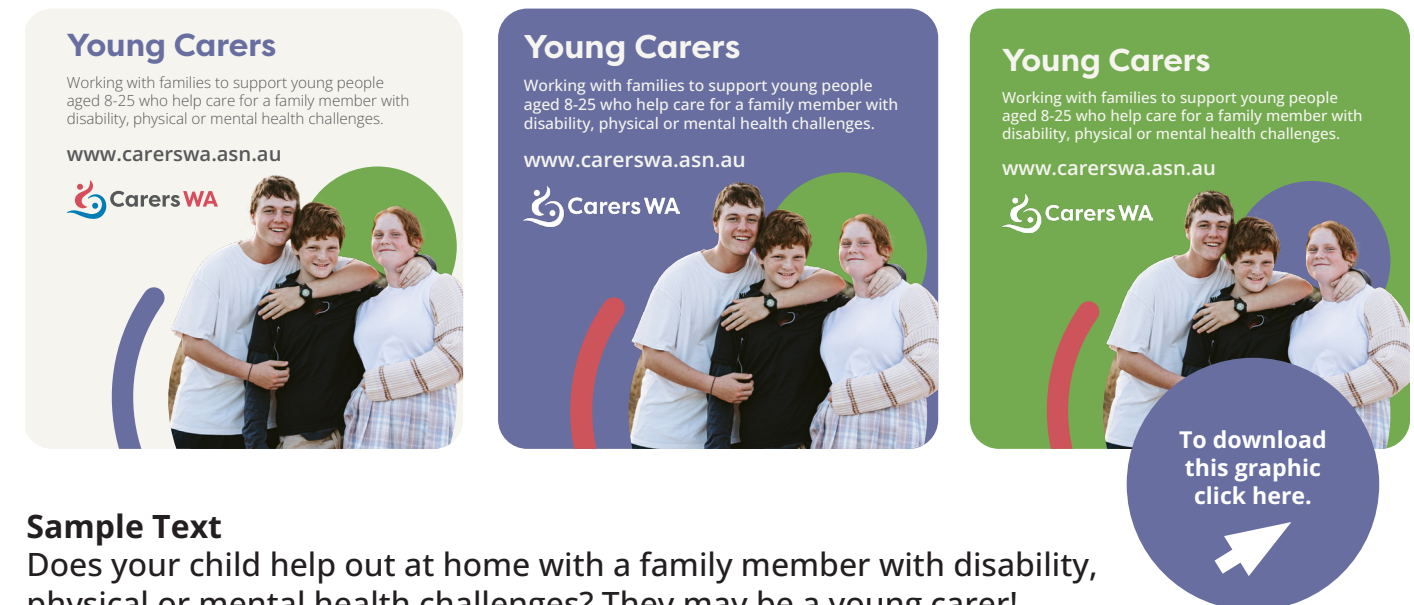
### Sample Text for Parents
